ORDINANCE 2000 - <u>O4</u> Approving a Preliminary Plat of Subdivision THE BLUFFS OF SILVER SPRINGS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, William Barbier, known as the sole beneficiary of Union Bank of Ottawa Trust #1057 and intended developer, did petition Kendall County for approval of a preliminary plat for a subdivision consisting of six (6) new, single family lots and a re-plat of an existing lot; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said petition did pertain to two tracts of land approximately 15.5 acres located north of The Woods of Silver Springs Subdivision Unit 1 in Fox Township; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said petition generally conforms to the Subdivision Control Ordinance, except private driveway length; and

 $\underline{\textit{WHEREAS}}$, said petition generally conforms to the Kendall County Land Resources Management Plan; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, all procedures required by the Kendall County Subdivision Control Ordinance were followed;

<u>NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</u>, that the Kendall County Board hereby approves a preliminary plat of subdivision for said tract of land entitled "The Bluffs of Silver Springs," and attached as Exhibit A, with the following conditions that:

- 1. The petitioner provide no more than six (6) new, buildable lots on the final plat, for a total of seven (7) buildable lots;
- 2. Suggested building sites be designated on the final plat;
- 3. Suggested well and septic locations be designated on the final plat;
- 4. The Agriculture Declaration Clause be included on the final plat;
- 5. The private drive shall not be dedicated to the public;
- 6. The private drive shall be labeled as a separate, non-buildable lot (i.e. an out-lot) on the final plat;
- 7. Provide emergency access easement seventy (70) feet wide to the property to the east;
- 8. The proposed Special Service Area Taxation District shall be approved prior to recording of the final plat; and
- 9. The only waiver to the private drive standards shall be length.
