ORDINANCE 2000 - 12 Amending a Planned Development Agreement DEER RIDGE SUBDIVISION

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Beverly Anderson, known as the beneficiary of the Beverly I. Anderson Trust, owner, and intended developer, did petition Kendall County for a zoning map amendment from A-1 to R-2 and a Special Use for a residential planned development and a final plat of subdivision for 10 single family lots; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the said planned development and said final plat of subdivision was approved on August 18, 1998, as Kendall County Ordinance 98-18; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said final plat and the planned development agreement conflict with respect to the number of lots below the minimum lot size requirements; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said conflict was the result of a plat modification at the direction of the Planning, Building and Zoning Committee of the County Board which was not accounted for in the planned development agreement.

<u>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</u>, the Kendall County Board hereby amends the Planned Development Agreement for Deer Ridge Subdivision in Kendall County Ordinance 98-18 as follows:

Section 4. B. shall allow five (5) lots of less than 90,000 square feet instead of the previously approved four (4) lots.
