ORDINANCE NUMBER 00-25

ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 99-17 AURORA BLACKTOP, INC.

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Jerome E. Leifheit of Aurora Blacktop, Inc. did make a request amend Ordinance 99-17 to relocate a tree buffer, for property located at 1250 East Beecher Road in Section 8 of Bristol Township; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance affects property legally described as:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 37 North, Range 7 East of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of the said Northwest Quarter Section for the point of beginning; thence North 88°32'04" East along the North Line of said Quarter Section, 953.68 feet to a point in the center line branch of Rob Roy Creek; thence South 28°38'25" East along the said center line, 1134.39 feet; thence South 87°53'03" West, 1498.53 feet to a point in the West Line of said Quarter Section; thence North 00°01'23" East along the said West Line, 1026.52 feet to the point of beginning; all in the Township of Bristol, Kendall County, Illinois; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said petition was approved by the Kendall County Board on May 18, 1999, as Ordinance Number 99-17; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Kendall County Board does have the authority to establish conditions pursuant to Section 13.07 K. of the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the condition in Paragraph 3. c. of Ordinance 99-17 stipulated the planting of trees along the north edge of the special use area; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the petitioner wishes to relocate these trees to an area along the north property line, along Galena Road, owned by the petitioner; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said the area in which the tree buffer is proposed to be relocated is outside of the prescribed legal description; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the petitioner recommends planting pine trees instead of the specified linden trees; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Kendall County Board finds that said changes are harmonious with the intent of the special use.

<u>NOW. THEREFORE.</u> <u>BE IT ORDAINED</u>, that the Kendall County Board deletes Paragraph 3. c of Kendall County Ordinance Number 99-17 in favor of the petitioner voluntarily planting pine trees along the north property line along Galena Road.
