

## ORDINANCE

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## AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Robert Bazan did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed map amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed map amendment on the 9th day of September, 1988 in the Kendall County Board Room and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps be amended; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby reclassified from A1, Agriculture District to R3, Single Family District and that the Zoning Administrator be hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map to show the change in zoning classification, legally described as follows:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 37 North, Range 7 East of the Third Principal Meridian described as follows:  
Commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 4 in Bristol Lake Subdivision; thence South 19°08'29" West along the West line of said lot, 171.42 feet; thence South 61°37'17" West, 786.99 feet for a point of beginning; thence North 61°37'17" East, 411.87 feet; thence South 27°42'43" East, 120.93 feet; thence South 61°37'17" West, 389.75 feet to a line drawn South 38°06'00" East from the point of

beginning; thence North 38°06'00" West, 122.69 feet to the point of beginning in Bristol Township, Kendall County, Illinois and containing 1.113 acres.
