Date: January 7, 2020

Kluber Architects + Engineers has completed cost revisions for the proposed renovation of the Pickerill estate house at Pickerill-Pigott Forest Preserve.

District staff recommends submission of a \$833,498.25 grant request for a total project cost of \$1,111,331.00, with a required \$277,832.75 match representing 25% of the total.

The completed project will complete the public access improvements including construction of a roofed-patio structure designed to accommodate solar panels at a future date to reduce energy costs. This project may be funded by the Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation following completion of an energy audit for the structure to determine approaches for reducing building energy loss. Kluber estimates that the building's current energy costs would be reduced by 50% based on current usage once the solar panels are installed.

Public access areas will include the first floor, and outdoor patio accommodating approximately 150 individuals.

The estate house conversion will serve as a multi-use recreational space. The District plans to coordinate programming with potential community partners including the Oswegoland Park District, Yorkville Parks Department, Waubonsee Community College, Kendall County Soil and Water Conservation District, Kendall-Grundy Regional Office of Education, and the University of Illinois Cooperative Extension. The facility will also be available for public rentals to further offset operational costs.

The District will be requesting letters of support from potential program partners in advance of submission of the grant proposal, which is due on January 21, 2020.

Recommendation:

Approval of Resolution #01-20-001 authorizing submission of an IDNR-PARC grant proposal in the amount of \$1,111,331.00 with a required match of \$277,832.75 representing 25% of the total project cost.
