WHEREAS, 705 ILCS 135/5-15 provides the defendant shall pay service provider costs to the entity that provided the service; and

WHEREAS, 705 ILCS 135/5-15 provides that service provider costs are not eligible for credit for time served, substitution of community service, or waiver; and

WHEREAS, 705 ILCS 135/5-15 provides that the Circuit Court may, through administrative order or local rule, appoint the Clerk of the Circuit Court as the receiver and remitter of certain service provider costs, which may include, but are not limited to, probation fees, traffic school fees, or drug or alcohol testing fees; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of efficiency, collection and reporting capability, designating the Clerk of the Circuit Court as the receiver and remitter of service provider costs is more effective way to collect these costs than having the defendant pay service providers directly.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The Clerks of the Circuit Court of DeKalb County and Kendall County are appointed as the receiver and remitter of service provider costs for their respective county, which include, but are not

limited to, probation fees, traffic school fees, drug or alcohol testing fees, and Victim Impact Panel fees.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* to July 1, 2019, and until further order of this Court.
