THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT the Local Rules of the 23rd Judicial Circuit shall be amended by the addition of the following:

RULE 1.60 (A) (2)

This section is deleted in its entirety.

RULE 1.60 (B) (1)

The current language within this section is repealed and is replaced with the following:

"1. Except as provided in these Rules, it is prohibited to take, transmit, record, televise or broadcast any photograph or audio or video recording within the DeKalb or Kendall County Courthouses without conforming to these Rules."

RULE 1.65 (F) (3) (f)

The current language within this section is repealed and is replaced with the following:

"3. At a break in the proceedings, and after the trial court judge leaves the courtroom, the media may leave the courtroom and may conduct interviews with the parties, families, witnesses, or the attorneys as provided in these rules. During the course of the interviews, the media may take, transmit, record, televise or broadcast any photograph or audio or video recording only in the locations specified in these Rules. In Kendall County, such interviews may take place in the Public Break area of the Kendall County Courthouse. In DeKalb County, such interviews may take place in the Jury Assembly Room. No parties, families, witnesses or attorneys are required to participate in such interviews."
