WHEREAS, the Departments of Court Services for the 23rd Judicial Circuit possesses and maintains certain documents needed by the Illinois State Police for the purpose of investigating applications for concealed carry permits; and

WHEREAS, 730 ILCS110/12(4) requires, with applicable exceptions, that probation records shall not be released "except upon order of the court"; and

WHEREAS, an application for a concealed carry permit includes a waiver of the applicant's privacy and confidentiality rights and privileges under all federal and state laws including those limiting access to juvenile court and criminal justice records and an affirmative request that a person having custody of any of these records provide them to the Illinois State Police (430 ILCS 66/30(3)); and

WHEREAS, Illinois Supreme Court Rule 21 provides that the chief judge of each circuit may enter general orders in the exercise of his general administrative authority; and

WHEREAS, obtaining certain records for the 23rd Judicial Circuit's Departments of Court Services would assist the Illinois state Police in its investigation of applications for concealed carry permits;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

That the 23rd Judicial Circuit's Departments of Court Services shall tender to the Illinois State Police, upon receipt of its request with the appropriate waiver, the records requested for the sole purpose of the Illinois State Police investigation of applications for concealed carry permits.
