MEETING MINUTES FOR WEDNESDAY, APRIL 24, 2019

<u>Call to Order</u> – The meeting was called to order by Committee Chair Amy Cesich at 8:31a.m.

With three members present, a quorum was established to conduct committee business.

Others present: Scott Koeppel, Laura Pawson

<u>Approval of Agenda</u> – Motion made by Member Vickers, second by Member Flowers to approve the agenda. <u>With three members in agreement, the motion carried by a vote of 3-0.</u>

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> – Motion made by Member Flowers to approve the minutes from March 27, 2019, second by Member Vickers. <u>With three members in agreement, the minutes were approved by a 3-0 vote.</u>

Monthly Reports

- Census Log Laura Pawson reviewed the census log with the committee.
- Bite Report Laura Pawson reviewed the Bite Report with the committee.
- Operations Report Ms. Pawson reported that all of the dogs came back to the kennel in early April. The Facility will not be fully operational until the full-time Assistant Warden/Kennel Manager, as well as additional part-time staff are hired.

Member Cesich reported that she and Sheriff Baird toured the Animal Control facility to discuss the possibility of County inmates assisting with a deep-cleaning of the facility, as well as monthly cleaning of the facility to improve the health and well-being of animals temporarily housed at the facility.

• Accounting Report – Ms. Pawson reported rabies tag sales are steady, fines and fees are low due to the drop in intakes since November 2018, and donations are going well. Mr. Koeppel stated that the Transportation, Board & Care line item is over budget due to the monthly payment to Countryside Vet Clinic for housing and care of Kendall County animals since the facility has been non-operational, and that the salary line for the

Assistant Warden and other salaries are down due to those position vacancies, and not being fully operational.

Chair Cesich asked for an update on the Chameleon software training. Director Pawson reported that she has not begum training because she is waiting for the other full-time staff member to be hired so they can be trained together. Discussion on the need for a time-frame for this training to begin for the Director within the next month. Mr. Koeppel reported that Latreese Caldwell will be involved in setting up the financial portion of Chameleon from the start of the new software utilization.

Discussion of the \$65,000 discrepancy in rabies tag revenues, and increasing fees prior to determining why there is an accounting discrepancy, the need for an audit of the Animal Control accounts, the Quickbooks receipt accounting system used for rabies tag sales, and deposit receipts. Mr. Koeppel stated that an internal audit of Quickbooks, and an actual hand count of tags for 2018, will be conducted to determine if there is a discrepancy, and why.

Old Business

- > Update on Hiring Process Laura Pawson reported that she has rehired one former part-time employee, and one new part-time employee, that are currently in training. A full-time candidate is meeting with Dr. Schlapp and Laura Pawson on Friday, April 26, 2019.
- Discussion of the Purchase of a Pressure Washer from the Capital Equipment Line in the Animal Control Fund Budget Scott Koeppel reviewed the proposal with the committee, which includes a 7-year part warranty and 1-year labor warranty. There was consensus by the committee to authorize the purchase of an industrial power washer in an amount not to exceed \$1,436.00 out of the capital budget line.
- Discussion of Minimum Wage Increase Mr. Koeppel reviewed his estimated proposal and projections for the part-time salaries each year until reaching the \$15. minimum wage in 2025, with the addition of increasing fees to accommodate the minimum wage increase. Mr. Koeppel also reviewed the capital fund analysis through 2025. Discussion on the estimated administrative costs, IMRF, and Social Security based on the salary increases, and the ending balance of the 2018 operating fund.

Member Purcell asked that the monthly accounting report include the year-to-date information of how many of each type of tag sold (1 year, 3-year, etc.) to show the exact number of different tags sold per year.

New Business

Discussion of Fee Changes – Mr. Koeppel reviewed hid ideas for fee increases. There was consensus by the committee to table fee increase discussions until the accounting issues are resolved.

<u>Executive Session</u> – Member Vickers made a motion to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of the review of discussion of minutes of meetings lawfully closed under the Open

Meetings Act, whether for purposes of approval by the body of the minutes or semi-annual review of the minutes as mandated by Section 2.06, 5ILCS 120-2, second by Member Flowers.

Roll Call: Member Cesich – yes, Member Prochaska - yes, Member Flowers –aye, Member Vickers - yes, Member Purcell - aye. With five members present voting aye, the committee entered into Executive Session at 9:28a.m.

County of Kendall, Illinois ORDINANCE # 2019-

KENDALL COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL FEES ORDINANCE

WHEREAS Kendall County has the authority to regulate animals and the possession thereof within the County limits. 510 ILCS 5/24, and

WHEREAS that authority includes the ability to establish fees to support the requirements established by the County and the services provided by the County. *See* 55 ILCS 5/5-1005; 510 ILCS 5/7; 510 ILCS 5/8; 510 ILCS 5/10; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of the County of Kendall, State of Illinois that hereafter the following animal control fees are established in Kendall County and shall be collected by the Kendall County Animal Control Department. These fees will then be remitted to the Kendall County Treasurer in accordance with section 7 of the Illinois Animal Control Act (510 ILCS 5/7), unless required otherwise by applicable state statute or regulation.

Section 1: Rabies Tags. The following fees shall be imposed on all individuals obtaining rabies vaccination tags for dogs from the Kendall County Animal Control Department:

- a. One-year tags: \$12 for an altered animal, and \$27 for an intact animal;
- b. Three-year tags: \$30 for an altered animal, and \$65 for an intact animal; and,
- c. Replacement tags: \$5 for a replacement tag, with proof of vaccination.

Section 2: Relinquishment Fees. The following fees shall be imposed on all individuals seeking to relinquish ownership of a dog to the Kendall County Animal Control Department:

- a. \$50 for a dog older than four months;
- b. \$25 for a puppy, four months or younger;
- c. \$50 for a nursing mother with puppies; and,
- d. \$25 for the first puppy in a litter of puppies, four months or younger, and \$5 for each additional puppy in the litter.

Section 3: Reclaiming Fees. The following fees shall be imposed on all individuals seeking to reclaim an animal, owned by them, but taken into the custody of Kendall County Animal Control Department, for whatever reason:

- a. *Impoundment fees:* \$45 for a first offense, \$95 for a second offense, and \$125 for each subsequent offense;
- b. Public Safety Fee: \$25 fee or the amount required pursuant to Section 8 of the Illinois Animal Control Act (510 ILCS 5/10), whichever is greater. This fee, however, shall be waived for a first offense, but only if (i) the animal has been altered or (ii) the animal is altered within fourteen (14) calendar days after being reclaimed and the owner submits proof thereof to the Kendall County Animal Control Department within a timely manner;
- c. Boarding fees: \$12 per day for each calendar day the animal is boarded by the Kendall County Animal Control Department or an authorized agent of Kendall County. A boarding fee will not be charged for the day the animal arrived at Kendall County Animal Control Department (if the animal arrived during the Department's regular business hours), or the following day (if the animal arrived after regular business hours);
- d. Rabies Vaccination Refundable Deposit: If an individual seeking to reclaim a dog does not present documentation to verify the dog is current with its rabies vaccination, the individual shall submit a rabies vaccination deposit before the dog may be reclaimed from the Kendall County Animal Control Department. The rabies vaccination deposit may only be refunded if proof of rabies vaccination is received by the Kendall County Animal Control Department within five (5) business days after the dog is reclaimed. The rabies vaccination deposit amount shall be \$40 for a first offense and \$80 for each subsequent offense;
- e. Spay/Neuter Refundable Deposit: If an intact animal is impounded by the Kendall County Animal Control Department more than once, the individual seeking to reclaim that animal must submit a \$40 spay/neuter deposit each time the intact animal is impounded after the first offense. No intact, impounded animal shall be released by the Kendall County Animal Control Department prior to receipt of the spay/neuter deposit. The spay/neuter deposit may only be refunded if proof that the animal has been altered is received by the Kendall County Animal Control Department within thirty (30) calendar days after the animal was reclaimed.

No animal will be released to the owner until all fees set forth in Section 3 have been paid in full.

Section 4: Adoption Fees. The following fees shall be imposed on all individuals who adopt an animal from Kendall County Animal Control Department:

a. Attached EXHIBIT A

No adopted animal shall be released by the Kendall County Animal Control Department until the adoption fees are paid in full.

Section 5: Superseding Prior Ordinances. Upon its effective date, this Ordinance replaces and supersedes all previous ordinances which establish fees for the specific circumstances identified above.

Section 6: Effective Date. This Ordinance and the regulations contained therein shall be in full force and effect on and after the date signed below.

X. RABIES CERTIFICATES AND REGISTRATION

Policy

Rabies vaccinations and registration (rabies tag) are required in Kendall County for dogs 4 months and up. If a dog cannot have a rabies vaccination due to health reasons, Kendall County Animal Control must receive a signed letter from a licensed veterinarian stating the dog's condition and why they cannot receive the vaccine. 510 ILCS 5/8.

Kendall County Animal Control strongly recommends any cat 4 months of age or older to also receive a rabies vaccine as a matter of public safety as well as for the animal's health. All cats in the care of Animal Control are vaccinated against rabies.

Veterinary Hospitals and Clinics that purchase Kendall County tags must complete an order form to receive tags. The order will be processed within 3 business days. Once the order has been processed they will receive their tags and an invoice. They will have 30 days to pay the balance. Kendall County Animal Control may halt the sale of rabies tags to a hospital or clinic if their account is past due. All hospitals and clinics must submit their clients' rabies certificates to Kendall County Animal Control at minimum once a month

Procedure

Anyone who does not receive a rabies tag from their vet hospital or client must purchase one from Kendall County Animal Control. They may do so by bringing a copy of their rabies certificate and payment any time during public hours or by mailing a copy of their rabies certificate and a check to Animal Control.

Upon receiving rabies certificates that do not list a rabies tag, Kendall County Animal Control will mail letters to residents reminding them that they are required to purchase a rabies tag for their dog and will have 7 days to do so. Animal Control will forward the information of people who do not comply to the State's Attorney's office.

Upon receiving rabies certificates that do list a rabies tag, staff or volunteers will enter the information into the computer database. The certificate will then be filed by tag number.
