<u>Approval of Agenda</u> — Member Kellogg made a motion to approve the agenda, Member Prochaska seconded the motion.

Items of Business

- Discussion of Lakewood Springs Club Forfeited Real Estate Taxes Dan Kramer, Attorney for the client, briefed the committee on the current situation of the Lakewood Springs Club subdivision in Plano, including the SSA bonds, and the bond holders. Mr. Kramer provided information about the bond holders, the bond administrator, the LLC who acquired the SSA bonds and the 200 lots. Mr. Kramer said his client went to the City of Plano asking them to pass an ordinance giving his client authority to cancel the bonds, which was approved in September of 2018. His clients then went to the HOA, with most of the improvements going to the subdivision. was asking the County to forgive the past SSA bond interest, and accept settlement of \$1,900
- Discussion and Approval to Transfer the balance of the State Pet Population fund to the Animal Control fund Motion made by Member Prochaska, second by Member Cesich to approve the transfer of the balance of the current State Pet Population to the Animal Control fund. With four member present voting aye, the motion carried.

- ➤ Kendall County Health Department Analysis Member Purcell led the discussion about the Health Department budget analysis, and the proposed plan to give the Health Department their full levy including monies they might receive from the Senior Tax Levy, and monies including the estimated 2019 benefit reimbursement. Mr. Purcell explained that the Health Department would sign an agreement with the County to pay the County for all of the Health Department employee benefits out of those budgeted funds provided by the County.

Voluntary Action Center (VAC), operator of Kendall Area Transit, is requesting Kendall County advance funds to our agency for operation of the KAT program, seeking most or all of our first quarter Downstate Operating Assistance requisition for \$189,000.

The reason for this unprecedented request is due to severe delays by IDOT in processing FY 19 contracts. For frame of reference, KAT's fiscal year runs July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. We are nearly nine months into the year, approaching \$900,000 in expenses as we wait for IDOT reimbursement. Under our agreement with Kendall County, VAC receives grant dollars from IDOT in a pass-through arrangement and is dependent on IDOT to process contracts and requisitions in a timely manner to ensure stable cash flow.

VAC has made great efforts to continue operations with lack of reimbursement. However, VAC has fully extended its line of credit of \$600,000 at this time. In January VAC had to request an additional \$200,000 line of credit in order to keep operating. This second line of credit matures March 8th, 2019. Many of our vendors are now in 60 day past due category as VAC struggles just to meet payroll needs. Further, the latest federal partial government shutdown has delayed contracts and payments from other federally funded programs.

DeKalb County and City of DeKalb have responded to our funding crisis by advancing funds. VAC has exhausted all resources from our financial institutions and seeking Kendall County's assistance to sustain KAT service until state reimbursement becomes available.

Fortunately, IDOT informs us that they have executed contracts, and payment approvals are expected to be sent to the comptroller's office in early March. I believe by conversations with our IDOT project manager that we should see our first requisition payments arrive in the next 30 – 45 days. Therefore, it is likely that the County will be reimbursed any funds advanced to KAT within that timeframe.

VAC's main concern, however, is having cash on hand to continue operating over the next 30 days while waiting for state payment. Advanced dollars from the County will ensure transit services continue normally while waiting for IDOT grant funding to arrive.

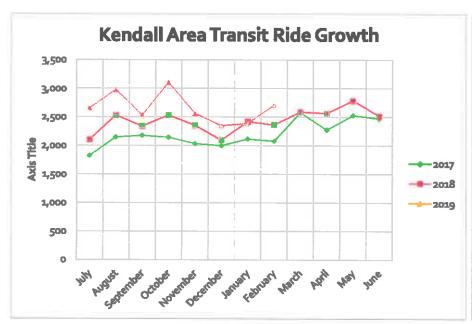

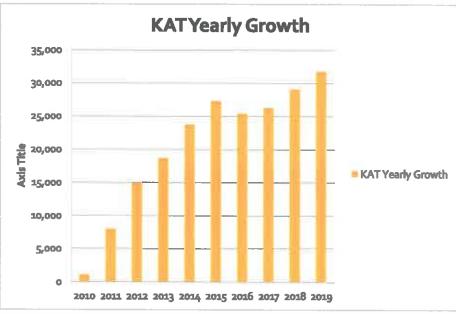

Good afternoon all.

I have had a few questions regarding the over/under funded IMRF balances. To get an idea of our funding we can look at the GASB 68 reports we received from IMRF. Unfortunately, we do not have the 2018 reports, only 2017 at this time. The 2018 GASB reports most likely will not be available until mki-April.

So, as of 12/31/17 our pension liability is as follows:

Regular \$550,926 Funded at 98.88% SLEP \$7,419,922 Funded at 85.50% ECO \$198,294 Funded at 96,54%

So, as of 12/31/17 we are not in that bed of shape. I have a feeling that we may see a decrease in our funded amount for 2018, but hopefully not by a lot. These estimates are very sensitive to a lot of variables so it is hard to predict year after year what it will be. As you can see on the pages I have attached down towards the bottom, a 1% swing in the discounted rate can fluctuate the pension liability in the regular plan by millions, from \$7.3 million underfunded to \$4.9 million over funded. You may want to hold off until April to make any decisions to see where we are at as of 12/31/18. ! have talked with the auditors regarding this and they caution making the decision solely on the Net Pension Liability.

Effects of Assumed Rate of Return Reduction on IMRF Employer and Members

Please forward this email to your chief financial officer and the senior member of your governing body.

In December 2018, the IMRF Board of Trustees reduced the return it assumes it will earn on IMRF's investment portfolio from 7.5% to 7.25%. This change affects IMRF employers and members in certain ways.

Employers

Each year, IMRF calculates a contribution rate for each IMRF employer. A significant factor in the contribution rate calculation is the assumed rate of return on investments. Since the return assumption is decreasing slightly, employer contribution rates will increase slightly in 2020. IMRF estimates the average employer contribution rate in 2020 will range between 10.15% and 10.65% of payroll. This estimate is higher than the 2019 average employer contribution rate of 9.06%, but lower than the 2018 rate of 11.24%. Each employer's actual rate will vary based on its IMRF assets, liabilities, and workforce demographics.

While the assumption change won't effect employer rates until 2020, it will effect multiple financial planning, accounting, and reporting calculations involving IMRF employer accounts in 2019. In addition to the employer rate calculation, the assumption change also effects the calculation of each employer's unfunded liabilities, and as a result, the calculation of its funded status. The calculation changes will be reflected in employers' 2019 GASB 50 statement, GASB 68 statement, Preliminary Rate Notice, and Final Rate Notice.

Members

IMRF members may make voluntary additional contributions (VAC) to supplement their standard

IMRF pension. Interest paid on VAC is linked to the IMRF assumed rate of return. Therefore, a decrease to the assumed rate of return lowers the rate of interest earned on VAC. IMRF credits VAC interest on December 31 each year, based on the VAC in the member's account on January 1 of the same year. Interest credited on December 31, 2018, was 7.5%, but due to the assumed rate of return change, interest credited on December 31, 2019, will be 7.25%. IMRF will inform members with VAC on file of the interest rate change.

Additionally, in certain circumstances, members may purchase IMRF past service credit. When members purchase additional past service credit, interest is included in calculating the amount owed. The amount of interest paid it linked to the assumed rate of return. As a result, an interest rate of 7.25% will be charged on past service purchases for service starting January 1, 2019, or later.

Dear Fellow IMRF Employer,

If your budget is anything like mine, you can't absorb substantial increases to your expenses. Property taxes are already so high that people have given up on political leadership from both parties...and are just exiting the State.

In December 2018, the IMRF Board of Trustees lowered their investment performance standard from 7.5% to 7.25%. On its surface, this might not seem like it would have a large impact on our budgets. However, the consultants who presented to the IMRF Board reported that our employer contributions, because of this decision, will increase approximately 1.4% of your entire payroll, both Regular and SLEP (Page 17, "Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, November 16, 2018"). In Kane County, we will have to find more than one million (\$1,000,000) more dollars that we simply don't have.

All of us, especially IMRF, can be very proud of their investment performance on our behalf. For example, according to the IMRF Update to the Kane County Board 5/29/2018 (page 9), "1982-2017 Annualized Return equaled 10.05% gross of fees" and according to the same report (page 8) "2017 Results equaled 15.96% Gross Investment Rate of Return".

A similar report presented on March 24, 2015 quoted the Annualized Total Fund return 1982-2014 at 10.24%. This is not the time to lower our expectations to 7.25% of their fine historical performance (as the attached letter requests). When they lower their standard, you and I have to pay lots more money.

Dear Board Members,

We, the undersigned County Board Chairmen and IMRF large employers, respectfully request that you reconsider and reverse your December 2018 vote to reduce your investment performance standard from 7.5% to 7.25%. We further request that explicit criteria be set for when employers will be required by the Board to shoulder an even larger share of beneficiary distributions with our employer contributions.

We deeply appreciate IMRF's outstanding long-term investment performance and past success in managing our funds. Historically, together we have enjoyed sustained investment performance in excess of 10.05% gross of fees (5/28/18 "IMRF Update to Kane County")

We collectively recognize that last year (2018), despite your best efforts and approximately \$114M (2017) spent on management fees and commissions, IMRF lost -4.31% of our funds invested. However, just the year before (2017), IMRF produced a gain of +15.96%! Including the catastrophe of 2018, over the past fifteen years, returns have averaged +7.77%. And, despite a very short-term perspective, the one-month return for January 2019 has been a resilient (approx.) +5.00%.

According to page 17 of the consultant's report presented at your December 2018 Board meeting, the reduction to 7.25% in assumed return will cause 2020 contributions from employers to increase approximately 1.4% of total payroll (range 10.15% to 10.65% in 2020 less 9.06% average contribution in 2019). This increase represents a substantial burden on top of our already strained finances...and puts even more upward pressure on property taxes.

According to "IMRF Update to Kane County 5/29/2018", IMRF funding ratio for all (combined) employers is 92.9%. In Standard & Poor's report, "U.S. State Ratings Methodology" (2011), S&P assigns a "strong" rating for funding levels above 90%; a rating "above average" for levels between 80% and 90%....

Therefore, we are being asked to pay more, and potentially increase property taxes even further, to fund IMRF in excess of the traditional definition of "full-funding".

We also request that you place this topic on your Board agenda with an opportunity for one or more of our delegation to speak within the next 60 days or sooner (but in no case after the date that preliminary contribution increase notices will be mailed to us).

Once again, we applaud your <u>actual</u> performance in producing consistent, long-term investment returns of more than 8%. We ask that you reconsider and reverse your expensive-to-us decision to lower your <u>projected</u> investment performance standard to 7.25% and instead maintain the <u>historical standard</u> that you have exceeded of 7.5%.
