WHEREAS, it would be more expedient to assign such cases at the time of filing to a judge who does not have any such conflict; rather than having the assigned judge recuse himself;

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Any newly-filed cases filed by the law firm of Kinnally Flaherty Krentz Loran Hodge & Masur P.C. which would routinely be assigned to the Honorable Stephen L. Krentz shall instead be assigned to the Honorable Melissa S. Barnhart.
- 2. Any newly-filed cases filed by the Law Office of Richard C. Claahsen which would routinely be assigned to the Honorable Melissa S. Barnhart shall instead be assigned to the Honorable Stephen L. Krentz.

- Any newly-filed cases filed by the law office of McAdams & Sartori, LLC which would 3. routinely be assigned to the Honorable John F. MccAdams shall instead be assigned to the Honorable Joseph R. Voiland.
- This Administrative Order shall only apply to newly-filed cases on or after the date of this 4. order and shall be effective upon entry.
