Fees and Charges Summary

Fees and charges were reviewed at the District's Finance and Committee of the Whole meetings.

The District is proposing \$10 R/NR fee increases for use of shelters and bunkhouses, and a \$10 R/NR per hour fee increase for use of Meadowhawk Lodge.

For larger weekend Lodge rentals for weddings and similar special events, the fee will be increased from \$1,800 to \$1,900.

The graduated Special Use Permit fee schedule for accommodating larger groups and events will be increased from [\$50 /\$150 /\$250] to [\$75 / \$200 / \$250].

Ellis Lesson Horse Transfer

The lesson horse transfer was reviewed at the District's Committee of the Whole meeting.

The Ells Lesson Horse "Willie" has been diagnosed with Cushing's disease and is no longer suitable for use in beginning lessons. The previous owner, who donated "Willie" to the District has expressed their desire to re-accept ownership.
