Scott -

I am writing in response to your inquiry about the status of Kendall County's RLF program. That program was capitalized prior to October 27, 1992. Per HUD's Notice CPD-04-11, RLF programs capitalized prior to this date no longer hold a federal identity and units of local government are allowed to retain program income from an RLF and expend those funds in any manner deemed appropriate by the community. Based on HUD's guidance, on October 11, 2016 DCEO sent Kendall County a letter stating that Kendall County's RLF program had dissolved.

I understand the JCAR may conflict with CPD-04-11. DCEO considered repealing the JCAR relating to the RLF program (and eventually still may do so), but in light of the fact that Kendall County no longer has an RLF program, those JCAR have no bearing on Kendall County and its use of the funds previously associated with the RLF program.

To reiterate, Kendall County no longer has an RLF program in the eyes of HUD or the State. Kendall County is free to use the funds previously associated with that program in any manner deemed appropriate by the community.
