#### VII. Mack & Associates, PC FY21 Audit Report

Cate Moulton from Mack & Associates presented a review of the Forest Preserve District's FY21 audit report.

A \$76,359 surplus was generated in the District's Operating Fund (Fund 1900) for FY21, with a total fund increase of \$291,491 following the transfer in of \$215,132 from the District's Improvement Fund.

Mack & Associates, PC reported the audit was clean of any significant deficiencies, with management recommendations presented.

The Committee of the Whole discussed the proposed changes to the General Use Ordinance #18-09-002. The proposed changes will be sent to the Kendall County State's Attorney's Office for final review for compliance with local, State and federal laws.
