Kendall County plans to extend a commitment of funding to the District to cover the future maintenance costs for those portions of the trail that remain within the boundaries of unincorporated Kendall County. Once the IGA between the District, Kendall County and the two municipalities are approved, the District will approve the IDOT letter of agreement.

• Building and Shelter Roof Replacement Project at Hoover Forest Preserve
