Commissioner Kellogg made a motion to forward an 8% annualized salary increase for full-time Grounds Maintenance Workers, Jared Anderson, Brandon Beerup, and Doug Neill, to Commission for approval. Seconded by Commissioner DeBolt. Aye, all. Opposed, none.

IX. Maramech Entry Gate Replacement Proposal and IPMG Insurance Payment Director Guritz presented a proposal for the replacement of the Maramech entry gate to be afforded by an IPMG insurance disbursement.

Commissioner DeBolt made a motion to forward the proposal for the Maramech entry gate replacement to Commission for approval. Seconded by Commissioner Gilmour. Aye, all. Opposed, none.
