The Office of the Public Defender for Kendall County is appointed to represent all individuals charged with felony and/or misdemeanor offenses who are required to appear before a judge for the setting of bond and other conditions of release, unless private counsel appears for an individual defendant. At the time of setting of bond and/or other conditions of release, the judge shall determine whether it is appropriate to appoint the Office of the Public Defender for Kendall County to represent the individual so charged during the pendency of the proceedings.

This Administrative Order shall be effective upon entry.
