WHEREAS, the records of this court show that cash balances remain on closed cases after payment of obligations in the cases;

WHEREAS, the efficient administration of justice requires that the Clerk apply such cash balances to other obligations owed by said defendant in other cases in this court; and WHEREAS, amounts of less than \$5.00 are considered de minimis;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, In the absence of a specific order from the trial court in the case in which a cash payment is made, the Circuit Clerk shall apply all cash from the defendant in the following order of preference.

- 1. To satisfy all fines, costs, restitution, and/or fees in the case on which the cash payment has been made
- 2. To satisfy all fines, costs, restitution, and/or fees due from the same defendant in any other case.
- 3. To refund any balance of \$5.01 or more to the defendant.
- 4. To assess a miscellaneous administrative fee of any balance of \$5.00 or less. This Administrative Order shall be effective on March 23, 2023.
