Approval of the Agenda – Member Hendrix made a motion to approve the agenda with the correction of "Approval of the November 13, 2018 Meeting Minutes" (correction of the year), second by Member Prochaska. With five members present in agreement, the motion carried with the suggested amendment.

<u>Public Comment</u> – Priscilla Gruber asked the committee to revisit the need of an Ordinance regarding the Illegal Discharge of Firearms in Residential Areas. Mrs. Gruber stated that she has witnessed shooting and bullets flying in her own neighborhood, and reported that one neighbor even sustained bullets inside his residence. Mrs. Gruber urged the Committee to move forward as quickly as possible for the safety and protection of Kendall County citizens.

♦ Coroner – Jacquie Purcell briefly reviewed her monthly and annual reports with the committee. Discussion about the County's participation in a lawsuit against pharmaceutical companies, and the Opioid Crisis.

- ❖ Circuit Clerk Written report provided. Ms. Ingemunson reported that they will have their first meeting with the Clerk Union representatives on December 20, 2018; and that her office is preparing for the auditors coming in January 2019.

- ❖ EMA Director Joe Gillespie reported that monthly testing continues. Written report provided.
- ❖ Public Defender Vicky Chuffo provided a written report and reported her office is experiencing an average of 237 additional cases per month versus the case load from last year.

- Sheriff's Report
 - a. Operations Division Written report provided. Chief Deputy Peters updated the committee on the two shooting investigations in Boulder Hill, and reported they made one arrest for the unlawful discharge of firearms, and that ammunition and drugs were confiscated during that arrest.
 - b. Corrections Division Written report provided. Chief Deputy Peters reported that they expect the arrival of tablets for inmate use at the end of January. They anticipate the tablets will assist inmates in obtaining education, in job searches, and in conducting legal research.
 - c. Records Division Written report provided. Chief Deputy Peters reported that the new KenCom system is live, and although they've experienced a few "bugs", the system is functioning well.

Items Worthy of notice to the County Board: The Supreme Court has issued new contact standards for the supervision of people placed on a term of community supervision through the Probation Department. These changes target our interventions to those determined to be of the greatest risk to

reoffend and present with the greatest need for services. While this realignment is designed to reduce the number of resources and man hours we provide to lower risk individuals, it does increase the amount and type of contacts we have with those identified to be in need. There is a significant increase in field contacts (home, school, employment, police departments, etc) resulting in the officers spending more time away from the office. This will have a ripple effect on resources and office coverage as we split our time between being accessible to the court and system players, as well as our clientele. The good news is we have a full year to comply with these new standards and there is little doubt that we will make this deadline. However, it will not be without some duty reassignment for our existing staff as well as an increased need for a full time male drug tester/administrative person. Whereas the majority of our clientele are male and often times have significant substance abuse issues (meaning they need regular urine drops), the majority of our officers are female. This results in an extra burden for the male probation officers to conduct drops on not only their own clientele, but also for the female officer's, and for civil cases when the court calls on us to assist. As we add the additional time away from the office, it will make it very difficult for male officers to do their jobs effectively. I am in the early phases of determining the impact these standards will have on us as we received them just last month. The drug testing, increased time away from office and the need for an additional vehicle are just the obvious items that have surfaced right away. I am committed to holding the line on expenditures and am exploring all options available to meet the needs of the department while ensuring we comply with the law.
