On April 1, 2025, a Consolidated Election will be held for all polling places in Kendall County.

The following methods of casting a ballot are available to all Kendall County Voters:

Vote by Mail: TBD pending completion of Consolidated Primary on February 25, 2025

Early Voting: TBD pending completion of Consolidated Primary on February 25, 2025

Grace Period Voting: TBD pending completion of Consolidated Primary on February 25, 2025

Election Day Voting: April 1, 2025

Any registered voter who is physically incapable of going to the polls on Election Day may apply to the County Clerk for a ballot to be voted at home. The vote may be cast by either the Vote by Mail or Disabled Voter Programs. An individual admitted to a hospital, nursing home or rehabilitation center, within 14 days of the election is eligible for the Hospitalized Voter Program. Pre-arranged Curbside Voting is also available for voters who are physically unable to enter the polling place. Please contact the Kendall County Elections Office at 630-553-4105 for information.
