15 Year Sentence for Possession of Methamphetamine with Intent to Deliver

Kendall County State's Attorney Eric Weis announced that Shaylan Preston (dob: 10/13/94, 4016 Foli St.) of Plano, Illinois was sentenced to 15 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections by the Honorable Jody Gleason on the charge of Unlawful Possession of Methamphetamine with Intent to Deliver, a Class X Felony, in a negotiated plea agreement.

According to Weis, law enforcement intercepted a package containing approximately 4,700 grams of methamphetamine from FedEx with an ultimate destination to a residential address in Plano, Illinois. Members of the Kendall County Cooperative Police Assistance Team carried out the delivery of the package while keeping constant surveillance. Preston eventually arrived at the residence and took possession of the package inside his vehicle. The vehicle was stopped, and the package of methamphetamine was recovered. Preston admitted that he was delivering the package to another individual. Preston was immediately arrested and remained on GPS Home Confinement under the Pretrial Safety Act until he was sentenced.

Preston will have to serve 75% of the 15-year sentence and will serve 18 months of mandatory supervised release upon completion of his sentence in the Illinois Department of Corrections. The case was prosecuted by Assistant State's Attorney Ryan Phelps. Preston was represented by Attorney Brian Erwin.
