10 Year Sentence for Drug Induced Homicide

Kendall County State's Attorney Eric Weis announced today that Macros Salas, (dob: 7/30/1987, 458 North Union Street) of Aurora, Illinois was sentenced to 10 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections by the Honorable Jody Gleason for Drug Induced Homicide on Monday. Salas had entered a plea of guilty to the offense of Drug Induced Homicide back in October of 2024.

The case began when members of the Kendall County Sheriff's Office responded to an address in the Boulder Hill subdivision in July of 2021 because of a young female who had passed away unexpectedly. When it was learned that victim died in part due to fentanyl intoxication, a month-long investigation was conducted. It resulted in numerous search warrants which found correspondence between Salas and the victim, as well as Salas and other individuals. These messages included admissions to provide the victim with illegal narcotics, which contained fentanyl, and included the cost of the illegal narcotics.

Weis commented, "10 years will not bring the victim back to her family and loved ones, but maybe it will dissuade the next individual from trying to make an illegal profit at the cost of another human beings life."

Due to the nature of the offense, Salas will have to serve 75% of his sentence and serve a term of mandatory supervised release for 18 months upon his release from prison.

The case was prosecuted by Criminal Chief Frank S. Gorup, and Salas was represented by the Public Defender's Office.
