If you are a Kendall County resident and on the LINK card, you can apply for free spay/neuter of your dog or cat. In order to receive a free spay/neuter voucher, you need to bring the following information to Kendall County Animal Control:

1. Your signed LINK card
2. Your driver's license or state ID
3. A current rabies certificate for your dog or cat

To be approved, the 3 documents must have the matching information including the name of the current owner and present address.

Once you have been approved by the Kendall County Animal Control staff, you will receive your spay/neuter voucher!
