WHEREAS, subject to the overall administrative authority of the Illinois Supreme Court set forth in Supreme Court Rule 21, and pursuant to the specific authority granted by Local Rule 1(B), the court is empowered to enter orders necessary to regulate the business of the courts;

WHEREAS, from time-to-time court dockets experience a high volume of cases along with a corresponding increase in the number of people entering the courthouse. As a direct result of this temporary increase in court traffic, enhanced security measures are required to ensure the safety of the public and courthouse staff and to ensure the orderly administration of justice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Commencing February 3, 2025 and continuing through February 7, 2025, courthouse security shall fully screen all persons entering the courthouse, and no one other than authorized extended media personnel, licensed attorneys, courthouse staff, and jurors impaneled to serve on a pending case, shall be allowed to bring a cell phone or other electronic device into the building.
