At Jay Woods Forest Preserve, Harold Smith, the adjacent land owner and farmer approached the District requesting support of clearing out a known existing drain tile located in the western quarter of the preserve. Mr. Smith has offered to excavate and expose the tile for clearing later this fall.

At Little Rock Creek Forest Preserve, trail washout is a concern for the recently installed bluff access trail/road. Existing infrastructure has been located and once cleared should address this problem.

At Subat Forest Preserve, a third proposal will be brought forward for clearing of a tile outlet into Rob Roy Creek once the District is able to confirm that the District's tile drains into the outlet structure identified during field investigations. The proposal for clearing the tile outlet is \$2,400.00

Recommendations:

Consider two separate motions to approve each of the two proposals received from Innovative Underground, Inc. to complete drain tile clearing and possible repair work at Jay Woods Forest Preserve for an amount not-to-exceed \$2,400, and a proposal received for hydro-excavation, discharge location and televising of pipe conditions at Little Rock Creek Forest Preserve for an amount not-to-exceed \$3,800.

Contributions for Grant-Funded Projects

Date: September 3, 2019

Kendall County Forest Preserve District is working to support completion of two grantfunded projects sponsored by the Forest Foundation of Kendall County.

The Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation awarded a \$5,500.00 Amenities and Events grant to support completion of the "Hobbit Tunnel" Nature Play Space.

In 2018 this project also received significant contributions from 100+ Women Who Care Oswego -Montgomery-Yorkville and TransCanada.

During the Forest Foundation's September meeting, the Board of Trustees will consider approval of a Waterplay Solutions activator post and base that will control water volume and timing of the proposed raised-stream feature. The quote extended is based on an interlocal contract for cooperative purchasing by the Houston-Galveston Area Council, Texas.

Direction will be requested for the District to enter into the interlocal contract to secure the reduced cost purchase will be presented for discussion at the upcoming Committee of the Whole meeting.

Separately, the Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation extended a \$5,500.00 Amenities and Events grant to support completion of a trail head kiosk at Fox River Bluffs Forest Preserve. District staff recommends moving forward with the purchase of an identical TK3 kiosk kit from Wilderness Graphics, including interpretive panel graphic design similar to the trail head kiosk installed earlier this year at Little Rock Creek Forest Preserve. As part of this request, District staff recommends extending \$1,425.84 in matching funds to support the purchase.

District staff are also recommends supporting the grant requirements to install interpretive/donor acknowledgement signs at the Hoover Nature Play Space and Hoover Forest Preserve's trail head to provide the public education and insights into the projects, as well as acknowledge partner/funder contributions.

Both projects need to be completed by the October 31, 2019 deadlines as stated in the ICECF grant agreements.

Collectively, the Forest Foundation of Kendall County has raised over \$50,000 over the past 4-years to complete Nature Play Space improvements and wildlife habitat improvement projects at Hoover Forest Preserve.

Recommendations:

- 1. Consider two separate motions to approve the acceptance of donations and volunteer support from the Forest Foundation of Kendall County to complete construction of the "Hobbit Tunnel" Nature Play Space Feature at Hoover Forest Preserve and Trail Head Kiosk feature at Fox River Bluffs Forest Preserve.
- 2. Consider a motion to extend \$1,425.84 towards the purchase of the Fox River Bluffs interpretive kiosk.
- 3. Consider a motion to approve the purchase and graphic design of two interpretive Durareader Interpretive Signs from Envirosigns of Salt Lake City, Utah for an amount not-to-exceed \$2,849.75.







Date: September 3, 2019

Genesis Nursery of Tampico Illinois extended the low-bid for the purchase of prairie seed mix for cropland conversion and prairie restoration projects at Fox River Bluffs and Hoover Forest Preserves.

District staff recommends moving forward with placement of an initial order of 22.5-acres of seed mix for the Hoover Forest Preserve restoration at a base-bid cost of \$930.33 per acre, and total purchase of \$20,932.43.

The District's remaining purchase of seed mix for the Fox River Bluffs cropland conversion project will be postponed pending the announcement of an award and subsequent grant agreement with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources expected in October.

Once the grant agreement is in place, the District can move forward with the purchase of the remaining seed mix which will be considered as the District's required match.

Recommendation:

Consider a motion to approve an initial order of 22.5-acres of prairie seed mix from Genesis Nursery of Tampico, Illinois for \$930.33 per acre (\$20,932.43 total) for enhancement of the Hoover core prairie area at Hoover Forest Preserve, with a \$7,650.00 anticipated reimbursement from the ICECF as part of the District's awarded K-12 Pollinator grant.


