Mr. Smiley also reported on the painter that the County has used for past projects, and possibly a discounted price in painting, as well as scheduling demolition and masonry construction. Mr. Smiley will be managing the project himself, and hiring individual contractors to complete the work. Member Cesich stated that we will also do public bids for the HVAC system installation next year.

New Business – Member Cesich stated that a citizen asked if Animal Control could post on their webpage, any stray animal with no collar or chip, before the adoption process is implemented. Ms. Pawson stated that she is working on that capability with the Chameleon software program and Pet Harbor.

Dupage County AC – Feral Fixers partnership. Dupage Co. rents Mobile Van to Feral Fixers and Dupage Co. Vet spay/neuters feral cats. Dupage is paid by Feral Fixers at discounted rate.

Kane County AC- No Feral cat partnership. Does not lend traps. Does not "refer", but will provide names of organizations who s/n feral cats. Kane has a barn cat program. Will adopt out barn cats for cats unsuitable for homes in unincorporated Kane to residents with farms with an adoption contract. No fee.

Grundy County AC-Lends Traps to residents with a deposit. Euthanizes feral cats.

DeKalb County AC- No Program. Does not take feral cats unless sick/injured and will be euthanized.

Will County AC- Rents traps to residents and euthanizes feral cats

LaSaile County AC- No Program, no referrals. Does not take in cats.

City of Aurora AC- Partnered with Humane Society of Aurora offers Barn Cat program for feral cats outside of city limits to people with barns with contract. \$0 adoption fee.

City of Joliet AC- Issues low cost referral forms to Mallard Point Vet for residents who want to TNR. Per Leann at C.O.J, it is Mallard Point Vet's program. Mallard Point charges the discounted fee. Joliet has a nuisance animal ordinance and it is up to the city to determine what a nuisance is. Joliet says not many participate and estimates no more than 10 a year because of the cost.
