I. AUTHORITY

Pursuant to §2-118.2 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/2-118.2), a hearing must be conducted upon receipt of a written request for a judicial hearing for a cannabis-related suspension issued under §11-501.9 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-501.9).

II. JUDICIAL HEARING

Upon receipt and filing of a written request for a judicial hearing for a suspension of driving privileges issued under §11-501.9 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-501.9), a judicial hearing shall be held pursuant §2-118.2(b) of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/2-118.2(b)), as follows:

- A. Within 30 days after the receipt of the written request; or
- B. On the first appearance date on the Uniform Traffic Ticket issued for a violation of \$11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-501) or a similar provision of a local ordinance.

III. HEARING DATE AND NOTICE

The Circuit Clerk shall set the hearing date as required in subparagraph A. of the preceding paragraph and provide notice of the hearing date to the person submitting the request, the State's

Attorney, and the law enforcement agency which issued the notice of the suspension of driving privileges in accordance with §11-501.9(g) of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-501.9(g)).

IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This General Order shall be effective on March 2, 2020, and until further order of this court.
