WHEREAS, in light of the COVID-19 Pandemic, and for the reasons set forth in General Order 20-03¹ dated March 16, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Waubonsee Community College, which provides the traffic school classes for the 23rd Judicial Circuit has decided to cancel all classes through at least the end of March, 2020, and possibly through April 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, certain defendants in traffic cases in the 23rd Judicial Circuit have been ordered to attend traffic school during this time, and thus they will be unable to timely complete the traffic school and provide proof of completion to the courts;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. All traffic cases returnable between March 17, 2020 and April 17, 2020 shall be continued to a future date at least 35 days beyond the original return date;
- 2. Any period of supervision or probation shall likewise be extended;
- 3. The Clerk of each county shall provide notice to each defendant of the new court date.
