## An Ordinance Granting Variance to the Kendall County Highway Access Regulation Ordinance

WHEREAS, access to Kendall County Highways has been regulated by the Kendall County Board through the Kendall County Highway Access Regulation Ordinance, adopted by the Board on May 18, 1999; and

WHEREAS, Raging Waves Water Park has petitioned the County for variance to said Ordinance to allow for full-access to the south side of Galena Road approximately 1600' east of Illinois Route 47; and

**WHEREAS,** said access is temporary in nature and shall not unduly impact the movement of traffic on Galena Road, nor jeopardize the safety of the traveling public; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kendall County Board, having considered all aspects and impacts of allowing a temporary access at the specified location, believes it is prudent to allow for the same.

**THEREFORE**, **BE IT ORDAINED**, that the Kendall County Board hereby grants a variance to the Kendall County Highway Access Regulation Ordinance, for the specified purpose, subject to the terms and conditions imposed herein.

- 1. The above listed recitals are incorporated herein as if fully set out herein.
- That a variance is hereby authorized for Raging Waves Water Park, for the purpose of a temporary, full-access driveway. Said access shall conform in all ways to the construction requirements of the Kendall County Engineer, and shall be constructed at no cost to Kendall County.
- 3. That said full-access shall be located on the south side of Galena Road approximately 1600' east of Illinois Route 47.
- 4. That the access shall be temporary in nature; and shall be closed to all traffic on September 2, 2008, and shall be physically removed from within the Galena Road right-of-way by September 16, 2008, including complete restoration of the Galena Road right-of-way.
- 5. Any exceptions, violations or noncompliance to the requirements contained herein, on behalf of the petitioner, will result in the immediate forfeiture of the variance.
