## ORDINANCE NUMBER 2007- 30

## MAP AMENDMENT FOR 2.003 ACRES ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF ILLINOIS STATE ROUTE 34 1/4 MILE EAST OF TUMA ROAD

Rezone from A-1 to R-2

<u>WHEREAS</u>. Erich Schoedl did file a petition for a Map Amendment from A-1 to R-3, for property currently owned by the petitioner and located on the south side of Illinois State Route 34, ¼ mile east of Tuma Road in Bristol Township; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said property is identified with the tax identification number 02-27-151-002, as legally described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, said property is currently zoned A-1 Agricultural; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the petitioner desires to rezone the property in order to divide the parcel into two (2) separate lots of 43,560 sq. ft. (1-acre) for the construction of a new single-family residence on the newly created lot; and

WHEREAS, said lots are less than the 45,000 sq. ft. as required in the R-3 zoning district; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the petitioner is seeking a variance from said minimum lot size requirement (Section 8.08.C.1.a of the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance); and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Zoning Board of Appeals has reviewed the requested variance and recommended approval; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Zoning Board of Appeals has recommended approval of the requested zoning change from A-1 to R-3; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, all procedures required by the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance were followed including notice for public hearing, findings of fact, and recommendation by the Zoning Board of Appeals; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Kendall County Board finds that said petition is in conformance with the provisions of the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance; and

<u>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</u>, that the Kendall County Board hereby grants a zoning map amendment from A-1 to R-3 on the tract of land legally described in Exhibit "A".
