## ORDINANCE 05-03

## KENDALL COUNTY RECORDER'S FEES

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/3-5018 provides that the statutory Recording fees may be increased by the County Board if an increase is "justified by an acceptable cost study showing that the fees allowed by this Section (55 ILCS 5/3-5018) are not sufficient to cover the costs of providing the services"; and

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/3-5018 requires a statement of the costs of providing each service, program and activity shall be prepared and be part of the public record; and

WHEREAS, a statement of cost (attached hereto and made a part hereof) and cost analysis by ECHOLS, MACK & ASSOCIATES, P.C. has been prepared; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED based on the ECHOLS, MACK & ASSOCIATES, P.C. study, the Kendall County Board recommends the Kendall County Recorder increase the Recorders Document Storage Fee from the current \$ 3.00 to \$ 9.00 Effective March 1, 2005.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Clerk shall publish notice hereof and send copies to <u>Treasurer</u>, <u>Supervisor of Assessments</u>, <u>Mapping and the Kendall County Board</u>.
