## ORDINANCE NUMBER 2005 28

## GRANTING A SPECIAL USE STONE CITY SOFTBALL, INC.

<u>WHEREAS.</u> Stone City Softball, Inc. filed a Special Use Permit application within the A-1 district for 10 +/-acres of a 40 acre property located on Bell Road, Minooka in Seward Township as depicted in Exhibit "A" and legally described as follows:

A parcel of 10 +/- acres, measuring 1320 feet by 330 feet subject to survey, located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 20, in Township 35 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in the Township of Seward, Kendall County, Illinois.

WHEREAS, said petition is to allow the operation of an 'athletic park'; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Kendall County Board finds that said petition is in conformance with the provisions and intent of the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance;

<u>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</u>, that the Kendall County Board hereby grants approval of the special use zoning permit to allow the operation of two softball fields that include concessions and a press box, dugouts, bleachers, and to permit the construction of a building for restrooms, equipment storage, and utilities, as well as a 20,000 square foot indoor training facility and associated parking subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Games must conclude and the lights on both ball fields will be turned off by 10:30p.m.
- 2. Coordination between the petitioner and the Township Highway Commissioner to ensure that the existing roads are adequate to handle the amount of traffic generated by the ball fields.
- 3. Review and approval of the submitted premise lighting plan prior to the issuance of a building permit to ensure said lighting does not migrate off of Stone City's property.
- 4. Review and approval of a landscape plan addressing the requested 2 to 3 foot evergreen tree berm plantings prior to the issuance of a building permit.
- 5. Site shall be developed in substantial accordance with the site plan attached as Exhibit "A".
- 6. Lighting in the parking lot will be directed in such a way as to not migrate off of the property.
- 7. The entrance sign will not be illuminated.
- 8. Hours of operation for the training facility are limited to 6:30p.m. to 9:30p.m. Monday through Friday and 8a.m. to 4p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
- 9. A chain link fence will not be constructed around the perimeter of the property.
- 10. Alcoholic beverages will not be sold on the premises and their consumption should be discouraged by the Stone City organization.
- 11. The sheriff's department will be notified in advance regarding when tournaments are occurring.
- 12. Maps, websites, and other printed material will be written to encourage traffic to utilize Grove Road to access the property.
- 13. The organization will post a 'No Left Turn' sign at the exit of the property, and the entrance and exit will be angled to the west to encourage traffic to utilize Grove Road.
- 14. Review and approval of engineering plans, septic plans, and a site plan by the Planning, Building, and Zoning Committee prior to the issuance of a building permit.
- 15. The Special Use permit will be reviewed as necessary.

Failure to comply with the terms of this ordinance may be cited as a basis for amending or revoking this special use permit.
