County limits the number of licenses to be issued as Class D Licenses to 2, and
WHEREAS, all licenses in said category are issued and outstanding, and
WHEREAS, a license heretofore issued to Clark Retail Enterprises, Inc. as a
Class D License has been (surrendered) (revoked).
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Article V, Section 1 be amended as follows:
The maximum number of licenses for retail sale of alcoholic beverage is as follows:
Class A5
Class B - 3 Class E - 0
Class C1
Class G0
In the event any license issued hereunder is surrendered, for any reason whatsoever, the maximum
number of licenses authorized in that class is accordingly reduced by the number of licenses surrendered.
No. further licenses may be issued until action of the Kendall County Board appropriately increases the
maximum number allowed.
