ORDINANCE

03-45 KENDALL COUNTY GIS FEE INCREASE

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/3-5018 provides that the statutory Geographic Information System fee hereinafter known as GIS may be increased by the County Board if an increase is "justified by an acceptable cost study showing that the fees allowed by this Section (55 ILCS 5/3-5018) are not sufficient to cover the costs of providing the services"; and

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/3-5018 requires a statement of the costs of implementing and/or maintaining such a document records system; and

WHEREAS, a statement of cost (attached hereto and made a part hereof) and cost analysis by MAXIMUS, Inc. has been prepared; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED based on the MAXIMUS, Inc. study, the County Board recommends the Kendall County Clerk & Recorder increase the GIS recording fee from the current \$3.00 to \$6.00 effective February 1,2004. The \$3.00 increase will be distributed as follows. \$2.00 will go to the Mapping Department G.I.S. fund and the remaining \$1.00 will go to the County Clerk's G.I.S. fund.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Clerk shall publish notice hereof and send copies to <u>Treasurer</u>, <u>Supervisor of Assessments</u>, <u>Mapping and the Kendall County Board</u>.
