ORDINANCE NUMBER 2002 - 02

PRELIMINARY & FINAL PLAT OF SUBDIVISION APPROVAL SHADOW CREEK SUBDIVISION

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Oswego Joint Ventures petitioned Kendall County for approval of a preliminary and a final plat for Shadow Creek; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said petition did pertain to a tract of land approximately 43.89 acres in area, located on the west side of IL Route 71, north of Hilltop Road in Kendall and Oswego Townships; and

WHEREAS, said property is legally described in Exhibit "A"; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said petition generally conforms to the Kendall County Land Resources Management Plan; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, all procedures required by the Kendall County Subdivision Control Ordinance were followed;

<u>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</u>, that the Kendall County Board hereby approves a preliminary and final plat of subdivision for said tract of land entitled "Shadow Creek Subdivision" and attached as Exhibit "B", with the following conditions that:

- 1. Pavement width may be reduced only if the developer obtains the appropriate variances from the City of Yorkville.
- 2. The engineering plans for the subdivision shall meet the requirements of the City of Yorkville and must be approved via a letter from them.
- 3. Landscape and detention plan shall be approved by the Forest Preserve District and the County Highway Engineer.
- 4. Compliance with all engineering requirements per Strand Associates, Inc. and Kendall County Highway Engineer.
- 5. Plantings to limit access for neighboring properties to the north shall be installed in compliance with the landscape plan attached hereto as Exhibit "C".
- 6. Landscape and detention plan to be approved by Forest Preserve District & County engineer. A signature block should be provided for the Forest Preserve

District on the final plat.

- 7. Create a trail stub out to Route 71, provided permits can be obtained from the Illinois Department of Transportation.
- 8. All letters of credit for public improvements and land-cash donations shall be submitted prior to recording the plat.
